Greetings from Nate & Mary Stanley

June 10th we were able to welcome a missions team down from **Common Ground Church in Glenwood**, **IA**. We had a wonderful week fellowshipping with them and introducing them to a few different parts of our ministry here. Their main goal was to help us get work done on a sewing center we have been wanting to get started for women here. And boy did they do a great job! They painted the inside and outside of the building, built 4 sewing stations with built in shelving, and a large cut table, and also painted a huge sign for the front of the building. We are so thankful for their hard work and for all those from **Common Ground** that also sent down many supplies and yards of material to help us get it all set up.



June 17th they flew back home to Iowa, and boy did God have his timing just right for them (as usual). The teachers here had been having peaceful protests throughout the state of Oaxaca since mid-May. Around the middle of June they joined forces with some more

violent protestors and things had started to escalate with their protests. They had road blocks set up throughout our state, which stopped the traffic that would be bringing gas and supplies to our side of the state. Thankfully one of our dear friends, Chucho, had some gas stored at his home that he gave to us in case of emergencies. That weekend the protests and blockades increased tremendously, and on Sunday the 19th, there was a violent battle in Nochixtlan between the protestors and federal police that were sent in to fix things. After multiple deaths and countless injuries, the police were unsuccessful, and the area was left to the protestors. As the news got out about the battle in Nochixtlan and resulting deaths, people became more furious with the government and more people joined the cause. This has resulted in even more road blocks popping up each day over this past week, which has caused not only severe gas shortages, but now food shortages as well. Beans, rice, oil, sugar and eggs are all very hard to find, and more than double their normal price once found. The state government has estimated that 1.5+ million people are without access to basic food items. Thanks to the faithful support of our home church, Turning Point at Calvary, and Cornerstone Baptist Church we have been able to purchase and distribute food supplies to our pastors and the villages where we work. We say of all of this, not only to update you on the situation here, but so that we can ask for your prayers. The government is meeting with the teacher's union as we speak trying to negotiate a solution. If they succeed the roads will re-open allowing food and gasoline to flow out to the villages once again. If they cannot reach an agreement then it is very likely that we are looking at a long term and potentially violent problem that will affect millions of innocent people.

As always, thank you to all of our wonderful supporters. Your prayers and support are an essential part to us being here, and we are so grateful for each of you!
