MISSION UPDATE - from Brandon & Hannah BAUGHN

We are excited to update you all about the next season of life and ministry for the **Baughn** family. Since coming back in January, we have been struck by the need to reach out and share among the flood of refugees, many of them Muslims, coming to

the USA. We have been surprised by the fear and anger towards Muslims often displayed by politicians, and sometimes even the church as well. We feel that we have the opportunity to build on our experiences in Pakistan to minister among Muslim Refugees in the USA, and to help equip the church in how to respond to Islam. With that in mind we have been investigating opportunities to minister among Muslim Refugees in Seattle. We have been blown away by the need! It has been exciting to talk to those who are currently involved in this kind of work and explore ways to partner. As we talk to TEAM and new contacts here, there are four areas of ministry we see ourselves helping with: 1. Serve the shepherd community in Pakistan by continuing to consult with the literacy education project. This will involve Brandon making 2 or 3 trips to Pakistan each year to maintain key contacts. 2. Work directly with Muslim Refugees in South Seattle. This will involve working with refugees in community development focused on community gardens, contextualized health curriculum, and organizing educational opportunities aimed at better integration. 3. Partner with World Relief by "adopting" refugee families and helping them transition to life in the USA. 4. Partner with World Relief to equip local churches in reaching out to Muslim refugees in the area.

We will give more information about each of these platforms as they develop. We have just relocated to South Seattle and are in the process of getting settled. After nearly six months of living in limbo we are very excited to settle into a new home. We are looking forward to seeing these opportunities develop and find practical ways to serve the refugee community, build credibility, and witness among the nations coming to our country.

Thank you for standing with us during this unexpected time of transition. We are trusting that this is all part of the Lord's plan for our lives and greatly appreciate your prayers as we move forward.
