MISSION UPDATE - Nate & Mary Stanley



Outside of the usual work here and the curveballs the summer brought, the Lord also allowed us to finally open up the sewing center Mary has been working so hard on! Before the twins were born Mary and I brought the kids with us everywhere. That allowed Mary to be able to work with the women in the communities and to lead Bible studies for them. Since the twins she has

had her hands full with 4 kiddos and all the hard work that comes with managing a household in a rural jungle community so she has been forced to stick much closer to home. The sewing center is attached to our current apartment and allows her to have a space to minister to and work with the women while still caring for the kids.

I would like to share a need with you that I would appreciate your prayers on. Schools are finally starting back here but because of the severe economic problems that been experienced by the people here, many parents simply cannot afford to send their kids to school this year. We usually sponsor a few kids but the need is much greater this year. We have 32 kids who are in desperate need of financial assistance or they will not be able to attend school. Thanks to the generosity of some friends, we already have scholarships for 10 kids, but we still need to raise the funds to support the remaining 22. If you, your church, or someone you know is interested in helping out, the total cost per student is \$100. That pays for the fees for the year, uniform and supplies. If you are interested please contact us and we will get you the names of the students still needing scholarships.

There is so much more I would love to share but space will not permit it. Thanks for all you do to support, pray, encourage, and care for us. We are truly thankful for each of you and what you do to allow us to be here doing Kingdom work.
