#### MISSIONS UPDATE - BAUGHNS

Dear friends and family,

Life and ministry continue to move forward here in Seattle. The busy season at the refugee urban garden is coming to a close. Brandon will continue to work with refugee participants to develop and design bilingual

learning materials. Brandon is also beginning to work with refugee families in helping their children transition to school in the USA. Please pray for one of the key contacts Brandon has made through the garden. Raj's transition to the USA has been anything but easy and he now finds himself sleeping on the couch of another refugee family, working nights to cover expenses for his younger brother and to send some back to his family, all while attending community college. Like many refugees and immigrants, he thought life in America would be easy but was met with expenses, odd hospitality practices, and a lack of any safety net. We have been engaging with some church small groups on outreach to Muslims and what a Biblical response to refugees is. Please pray that people would understand Christ's love for the international community within our borders and the need to share His truth with them. We are excited to have established contact with some Pakistani asylum seekers here in Seattle on social media. Brandon also spent 10 days in Jakarta, Indonesia this past month and enjoyed visiting with a ministry there. We hope to share more about this in the future. Finally, we want to say THANK YOU for your continued prayers and support. We have been keenly aware of your faithfulness during these sudden and ongoing changes in our lives and ministry.
