#### MISSION UPDATE -Adam/Renae Sperling

Even in light of our exciting move to Colorado Springs at the end of the school year, we are still so excited to tell you what God is doing here on the campus of the University of Wyoming. In the midst of a growing number of students getting involved with us, our

commitment to developing individual men and women stays the same. We fully believe that as students get a vision for disciple-making in college and then begin experiencing it, they will more likely continue that throughout their lives.

My new role as the EDGE Director will allow us a wider influence of how this happens around the nation. The major emphasis of the EDGE experience is that our recent grads can join us on campus for one or two years for a "master's degree"" in disciplemaking. We will send these 160 EDGE staff to campuses all over the country, including the University of Nebraska and Iowa State. We will have a wider influence than we have ever had in staying precision-focused on trusting God to raise up part of the next generation of faith-filled leaders.
