"My name is **Danielle Pint** and I'm a mother of three young boys ages 3, 7, 8 battling stage 4 metastatic breast cancer. This battle has been going on for almost 3 years now. My husband, Ryan, and I were recently presented with an opportunity to do Hyperbaric Oxygen treatments to help heal open wounds on my chest that have been present for the past year-and-a-half. In addition to helping heal the wounds, cancer does not like oxygen and we expect to see improvements there as well. The money raised will go to treatment expenses as well as travel costs (gasoline). I will be commuting weekly for 10 weeks to complete the treatments beginning the week of January 23rd. Thankfully, the full treatment cost does not need to be paid up front, but can be paid ahead of time in smaller increments. The cost is \$175/treatment. Money is needed as soon as possible in order for treatments to begin. However you can help would be greatly appreciated!"

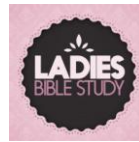

THANK YOU from the BAUGHNS

The Christmas boxes were a hit! We were able to involve the whole family by making separate Christmas visits to our Afghan refugee friends. This was the first Christmas for each family we visited, and it is safe to say the only gifts their children received were from you all. It is not Afghan custom to open gifts in front of the giver, but they sent texts after saying thank you and that their kids loved it! It also opened the door to share the meaning of Christmas. One of the families served us an amazing Afghan meal when we arrived and asked us to explain why we celebrate Christmas. Through the Quran they have heard small pieces of the story but really do not have a clear understanding of what the Bible teaches. We also shared these gifts with our missionary colleague here in Seattle. They hosted an "Emmanuel Dinner" for Afghan and Somali refugees and ended up having many families attend. They read the Christmas story from the Gospels and were able to hand out your gift boxes to each child there.

So, thank you all so much for the time and effort you put into making this a special first Christmas for our refugee friends here in Seattle. It is always amazing to see how the Church can come together, even from different parts of the country, to take part in sharing Christ's love and Good News with neighbors from all over the world.
