"Things are up and running in Laramie, and our students are busy on campus with classes. It's only been a couple weeks so far, but plenty of people are already stressed about exams and papers. Through all the worrying, however, many of our students are involved in Joshua

Team, which is our 5-week training class for freshmen and new students. In Joshua Team, we discuss how to have a thriving relationship with God, and how we can share our faith with those around us. Around 50 new students joined Joshua Team this semester, and another 40 students and staff are helping coach the new students individually through all the content. It is an intensive class that involves memorizing verses every week, reading assignments, daily quiet times, sharing your faith with new people, and even starting an Investigative Bible Conversation (IBC) in dorms and in friend groups. Many students are nervous about the upcoming assignments where they share the gospel with a non-Christian friend, so pray that they are filled with courage because the Lord is with them (Joshua 1:9)".
